### **ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS:**

The **Fulbright U.S. Student Program** currently awards approximately 1,900 grants annually in all fields of study and operates in more than 140 countries worldwide. There are several programs to which you can apply, but in general Fulbright grants are for the purpose of studying/ conducting research or teaching English overseas. Fulbright grants are typically between 8-10 months and provide funding for round-trip international travel, monthly maintenance allowance, health and accident coverage, and occasionally tuition costs.

**Gilman and Boren** provide money for study abroad programs with a preference for less commonly-studied languages (e.g. Arabic, Chinese, Russian). Gilman students must be receiving a Pell Grant. You can apply for Gilman or Boren as early as your freshman year. Both can be used to fund study abroad programs offered by DePaul as well as non-DePaul programs.

The Fulbright deadline is **October 4** and the Gilman deadline is **October 3** (for Spring 2018 study abroad programs). If you are interested in one of these scholarships, but do not plan on applying in the current cycle, you will still find the information session useful. These grants are highly competitive and prestigious, so the earlier you start planning the better.
